## About David H. Moore

David H. Moore, WVU's 2021 John T. Copenhaver, Jr. Chair, is a professor of law at Brigham Young University and an international human rights scholar. Additionally, Moore currently serves on the Organization for Security and Co-Operation in Europe's Moscow Mechanism, providing expertise to address specific human rights concerns.

Moore holds the Sterling and Eleanor Colton Endowed Chair in Law and is the associate director of the Brigham Young University International Center for Law and Religion Studies, which helps secure international religious freedom. In 2020, he was elected to a brief term on the United Nations Human Rights Committee, a body of independent experts that monitors states' implementation of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights. Moore also served as acting deputy administrator and general counsel of the U.S. Agency for International Development and clerked for Justice Samuel A. Alito, Jr., and he has an extensive academic career that spans Brigham Young University, George Washington University, University of Kentucky and University of Chicago.
